Title: Certification of Vision Impairment

Certification is the pre-requisite to registration with a vision impairment. People with vision impairment that meet certain criteria^{1,2} are eligible to be registered with their local authority social services department as sight impaired (SI) or severely sight impaired (SSI). Registration ensures access to services and support aimed at maintaining a person's independence. In Wales, Consultant Ophthalmologists currently sign a Certificate of Vision Impairment (CVI). However, there is no legal requirement in Wales stating that only a Consultant Ophthalmologist can sign a CVI.

Recent research concluded that there is comparable agreement with regards to certification eligibility between ophthalmologists and optometrists trained and accredited to deliver low vision services, relative to a consensus panel³. Accordingly, a new All-Wales patient pathway will be introduced that will enable patients to be certified as visually impaired by Wales Eye Care Services (WECS) optometrists who are low vision accredited and have completed an approved training module as determined by Health Education and Improvement Wales (HEIW) and outlined in WECS Standard Operating Procedures. This will be in addition to Consultant Ophthalmologists certifying patients. This new approach aligns to the principles of prudent healthcare and our commitments in *A Healthier Wales* and *the Future Approach for Optometry Services*.

(NB Prior to optometry contract reform, the accreditation required is Eye Health Examination Wales (EHEW) plus Low Vision Service Wales).

Four changes have been made to the existing Certification of Vision Impairment Wales (CVIW) form to accommodate this:

- The heading *“To be completed by the Ophthalmologist (tick one)”* changed to *“To be completed by the Ophthalmologist/Optometrist (tick one)”*,
- Inclusion of tick boxes to indicate whether the practitioner is an ophthalmologist or optometrist,
- Inclusion of tick boxes to indicate whether certification was performed within the hospital eye service, an optometry practice or a mobile setting
- The label *“Hospital address”* changed to *“Certifiers primary hospital/optometry practice address”*

The same CVIW 2024 form will be used for certification in primary and community care and in secondary care. The patient pathway for this service can be found in the relevant clinical manuals.

Mae cael ardystiad yn rhagamod ar gyfer cofrestru gydag amhariad ar y golwg. Mae pobl sydd ag amhariad ar y golwg sy'n bodloni meini prawf penodol^{1,2} yn gymwys i gael eu cofrestru gydag adran gwasanaethau cymdeithasol eu hawdurdod lleol fel unigolion sydd ag amhariad ar y golwg (SI) neu sydd ag amhariad difrifol ar y golwg (SSI). Drwy gofrestru, bydd unigolion yn cael mynediad at wasanaethau a chymorth sydd wedi'u cynllunio i'w helpu i aros yn annibynnol. Yng Nghymru, ar hyn o bryd, Offthalmolegwyr Ymgynghorol sy'n llofnodi'r Tystysgrif Amhariad ar y Golwg (CVI). Fodd bynnag, nid oes gofyniad cyfreithiol yng Nghymru sy'n datgan mai dim ond Offthalmolegydd Ymgynghorol all lofnodi'r Tystysgrif Amhariad ar y Golwg.

Daeth ymchwil ddiweddar i'r casgliad, o safbwynt nodi cymhwysra unigolion i gael tystysgrif, fod cytundeb tebyg rhwng offthalmolegwyr a phanel consensws o'i gymharu â'r cytundeb rhwng optometryddion sydd wedi'u hyfforddi a'u hachredu i ddarparu gwasanaethau golwg gwan a'r panel consensws³. Yn unol â hynny, bydd llwybr cleifion newydd i Gymru gyfan yn cael ei gyflwyno a fydd yn galluogi cleifion i gael eu hardystio yn unigolion sydd ag amhariad ar y golwg gan optometryddion Gwasanaeth Gofal Llygaid Cymru sydd wedi'u hachredu i ddarparu gwasanaethau golwg gwan ac sydd wedi cwblhau modiwl hyfforddiant cymeradwy, fel y pennir gan Addysg a Gwellu Iechyd Cymru ac fel yr amlinellir yng Ngweithdrefnau Gweithredu Safonol Gwasanaeth Gofal Llygaid Cymru. Bydd hyn yn ychwanegol at yr ardystiad ar gyfer cleifion a gynhelir gan Offthalmolegwyr Ymgynghorol. Mae'r dull newydd hwn yn gyson ag egwyddorion gofal iechyd darbodus a'n hymrwymiaadau yn *Cymru Iachach a Gofal Iechyd Llygaid GIG Cymru: Dull Gweithredu ar gyfer Gwasanaethau Optometreg yn y Dyfodol*.

(Noder: Cyn diwygio'r contract optometreg, achrediad Archwiliadau Iechyd Llygaid Cymru ynghyd â Gwasanaeth Golwg Gwan Cymru sy'n angenrheidiol).

Mae pedwar newid wedi'u gwneud i'r ffurflen Tystysgrif Amhariad ar y Golwg Cymru (CVIW) bresennol er mwyn gallu rhoi'r drefn newydd ar waith:

- Mae'r pennawd "*I'w gwblhau gan yr Offthalmolegydd (ticiwch un)*" wedi cael ei newid yn "*I'w gwblhau gan yr Offthalmolegydd/Optometydd (ticiwch un)*"
- Mae blychau dewis opsiwn wedi'u cynnwys i nodi p'un a ydy'r ymarferydd yn offthalmolegydd neu'n optometrydd
- Mae blychau dewis opsiwn wedi'u cynnwys i nodi a gafodd yr ardystiad ei gynnal mewn gwasanaeth llygaid yn yr ysbyty, practis optometreg neu leoliad symudol
- Mae'r label "*Cyfeiriad yr ysbyty*" wedi cael ei newid yn "*Cyfeiriad prif weithle y sawl sy'n ardystio (ysbyty/ practis optometreg)*"

Bydd yr un ffurflen CVIW 2024 yn cael ei defnyddio ar gyfer ardystio mewn gofal sylfaenol a chymunedol a gofal eilaidd. Mae'r llwybr cleifion ar gyfer y gwasanaeth hwn i'w weld yn y llawlyfrau clinigol perthnasol.
