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The Person Behind the Role: Well-being and purpose in Optometry by Sheena Tanna-Shah launched on 2 September 2026, with a free ebook available to everyone working or studying within UK optometry sponsored by Optometry Wales.

Written in response to the growing pressures experienced across the profession, the book explores wellbeing, identity, confidence and the importance of looking after the individual behind every role.

People are often recognised for what they do, the responsibilities they carry and the support they provide to others. The Person Behind the Role encourages readers to pause and consider the human being behind those expectations regardless of their job title, position or stage in their career.

Author Sheena Tanna-Shah said:

“We spend so much of our lives fulfilling roles at work, at home and within our communities that it can be easy to lose sight of ourselves as individuals.

“This book is an invitation to pause, reflect and reconnect with the person behind those responsibilities. I wanted it to feel honest, accessible and relevant to the real challenges people face, rather than presenting wellbeing as another task to complete.”

Although inspired by Sheena’s experiences and conversations within optometry, its themes extend beyond any one profession. The book explores the quieter pressures that can affect people at every stage of their lives and careers, including self-doubt, exhaustion, changing priorities and the expectation to appear as though everything is under control.

The significant support of Optometry Wales has made it possible for the digital edition to be offered free to everyone working or studying within UK optometry. Its commitment to the project has been instrumental in helping this important message reach people across the profession.
